Its functional objectives are:

- Design, planning and implement of actions in the field of training.
- Technology Dissemination and participation in educational projects aimed at both the training of individuals and the training of professionals.

In 2014, FEI established its authorised Regulated Vocational Training centre under registration number: 28075595. The centre is accredited with the Erasmus+ Charter for Higher Education.

In these centres he trains **more than 1000 students** annually in **job training** and more than **800 in vocational training** in the education system.

This growth has been supported by the incorporation of new functional areas, projects, development of computer products and educational content and digital marketing.

Due to its effort of constant improvement, FEI is certified in the following quality systems:

- **ISO 9001- 2015** International Quality Management System of the processes that the organization carries out for the development of its training activities since 2002.
- **EFQM** European Quality Model: the entity is certified by a licensee of the Quality Management Club, with a result in the self-evaluation of more than 600 points, which are equivalent to the **GOLD seal** as recognition of the quality and excellence of our training and according to the EFQM Model of Excellence.

Since 2017, FEI actively participates in Mobility partnerships of Erasmus+ programmes in order to collaborate with institutions in Europe and Asia.

- **CARTES Mobility Consortium**, together with other vocational training centres in Spain and in collaboration with educational institutions (training centres and universities),
- **2017-2019**: Mobilization of teachers and coordination staff to countries such as Albania and Serbia
- **2019-2020**: Mobilisation of teachers for their training and professional development to companies in Italy, and universities in the Philippines, Albania and Bosnia. This kind of mobilities are very useful for synergies between vocational training centres and enterprises.
